## Summer School and Ph.D. Student Forum

#### Summer School on Specification and Design Languages – Stockholm, 2 - 6 September 2024

The second edition of the Summer School on Design and Specification Languages is targeted at students, researchers and R&D experts from academia and industry, who want to learn about languages, tools and techniques for developing software and hardware systems. The school will cover a diverse array of essential topics encompassing modeling, specification, and verification for a wide spectrum of systems, including cyber-physical systems, distributed systems, embedded systems, real-time systems, and the Internet-of-Things.



The school will be co-located with the Forum on specification and Design Languages 2024. Over the course of five days, participants can expect a dynamic program featuring lectures, demonstrations, hands-on tutorial sessions, and insightful discussions.

The school program will span over five days: the first two days will be dedicated solely to the school activities, featuring full-length lectures from leading experts in the field, talks given by experts from academia and industry, and discussion sessions where the students may discuss their research with peers and senior researchers. In the last three days, the school program will overlap with the main conference program. Participants will have the opportunity to attend talks and presentations showcasing the latest advancements in modeling and specification languages for system design, directly engaging with the main innovators in the field.
